### How to Become a Member

The Glencoe Club is inviting candidates to join our Prospective Database, which secures the ability to apply for Social Membership in the future. When Social Membership becomes available, those on our Prospective Database will be notified (in the order applications are received) and will have a limited opportunity to complete an application. A Prospect does not have any membership privileges.

A Prospective Database application can be requested by contacting our team at [membership@glencoe.org](mailto:membership@glencoe.org). A non-refundable \$1,000\* application fee is required.

### What is Social Membership?

Becoming a Social Member is the first of three steps towards obtaining full Active Membership. When invited to apply for Social Membership, the Prospect will be asked to provide two references from current Club members. Upon submission of the Social application, 25% of the entrance fee, in effect at that time, is required. Applications are then reviewed by the Membership Committee and passed on to the Board of Directors for approval. Once the application is approved, the applicant will be placed on our Social Waitlist and will have access to the Club's Food & Beverage and Club Services.

### Membership Privileges at a Glance

#### Social Membership (Adults Only)

Full use of Food & Beverage Facilities and Club Services (Pro Shop, Physiotherapy, Wellness Centre and Golf Centre). May book advanced group functions in Curling and Bowling.

#### House Membership

Full use of Food & Beverage Facilities and Club Services (Pro Shop, Physiotherapy, Wellness Centre and Golf Centre) and unlimited use of Bowling, Curling and Skating. House Members may also use the other sports facilities once per month by registering at the Sports Office. Children can be added onto the account at eight weeks of age. House Members may register children 17 years of age and under in all programs 48 hours after Active registration commences. Children may have limitations on drop-in pool and court usage based on their age and supervision requirements

#### Active Membership

Active Members have use of all Club facilities.

## How Do I Become a Full Active Member?

The second step is a one-time offer to move from Social to House Membership. Once the Board of Directors has decided the number of activations for the upcoming membership year, Social Members move to House Membership. House Members are required to pay an additional 25% of the current entrance fee in effect at the time of activation. The remaining 50% of the current entrance fee in effect at the time of activation will be required when a Member is activated from House Membership to Active Membership. Members do not have the option of remaining House Members and must continue to Active Membership when their account is activated. The Glencoe Club's current entrance fee is \$65,000.\*

The number of yearly activations determined by the Board is dependent on a number of different factors. Waitlist times from Social to House and House to Active are difficult to predict and are not guaranteed.

*Please note that all entrance fee amounts paid are non-refundable and non-transferable.*
